



Directions to Make Fleece Tie Blankets

Materials Needed:

- Sharp scissors
- Large safety pins (optional)
- Cardboard

Blanket Sizing:

- 2 ½ yards of printed fleece fabric
- 2 ½ yards of solid fleece fabric

Directions:

1. With both pieces of fleece fabric in hand, lay **WRONG** (duffy/back) sides together (i.e., fabrics touching each other inside the blanket).
2. Trim off salvage edges on any or all sides of the blanket so the two pieces of fleece fabric are the same size. Try to cut as straight as possible.
3. Place large safety pins through both pieces of fabric approximately 6 inches from the edge on all sides to secure the two pieces of fabric together.
 - a. If you are working on the floor with room to spread out, the material won't move, so you may skip this step.
4. Using your cardboard cutting guide (see guide on the next page), cut out a 4-inch square on each corner.
5. Cut 1-inch wide strips through both pieces of fabric that are 4 inches long (see fabric strip guide on the next page) on each side of the blanket.
6. After cutting fabric strips on all sides, tie **DOUBLE** knots in the fabric strips all the way around the blanket.
